Part 2: Mentoring and Practice (two days)

These sessions focus on an introduction to effective teaching and resources to support your GTAs as instructors. GTAs will learn classroom management and active learning strategies, and practice teaching in a supportive environment. They will also have the opportunity to discuss their concerns and questions with the Teaching and Learning Commons staff and experienced GTA mentors.
